

Statutory Notice: RCO 37

PARISH WALK NOTICE 2021

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Notice under section 38 of the Highways Act 1986.

1 Title

This Notice is the Parish Walk Notice 2021.

2 Commencement and expiry

This Notice comes into operation on 19 June 2021 and expires on 20 June 2021.

3 Roads closed to motor vehicles

The roads specified in Schedule 1 are closed to motor vehicles during the period specified in column 4 of that Schedule.

4 Imposition of one way traffic

The roads specified in Schedule 2 are subject to a one-way restriction during the period specified in column 4 and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel otherwise than in the direction specified in column 5 of that Schedule.

5 Temporary speed limit

The roads specified in Schedule 3 are subject to a temporary speed limit and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel in excess of 30 mph during the periods specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

6 Imposition of no waiting

A temporary no waiting restriction will be imposed and parking is suspended on the roads specified in Schedule 4 during the periods specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

7 Exemptions

(1) Paragraphs 3 and 6 shall not apply to –

(a) emergency service vehicles; and



- (b) a vehicle approved by the organiser (Manx Harriers Athletics Club) which may include a vehicle requiring access to their property situated on the roads specified in Schedule 1.
- (2) Paragraph 4 shall not apply to emergency service vehicles and vehicles authorised by the organiser.
- (3) Paragraph 5 shall not apply to emergency service vehicles.

8 Appointment of Marshals

- (1) The organiser must appoint marshals¹ in respect of any race to be held pursuant to this Notice.
- (2) In relation to the appointment of marshals, the organiser must comply with section 9 of the Road Races Act 2016.

9 Cancellation etc.

- (1) If the organiser is given a change notice² —
 - (a) where the notice suspends or revokes this Notice; or
 - (b) where the notice varies this Notice and the Department directs the organiser to do so,the organiser must stop, cancel, suspend or postpone the event or any part of the event specified in the notice.
- (2) In any case to which sub-paragraph (1) applies, the organiser must notify the senior police officer³ and take such measures as the organiser considers appropriate to inform the public of the effect of it.

10 Notification of end of temporary restriction

At the end of each period that a traffic restriction is in force, the organiser must make such provisions as seem expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the event or any part of the event.

11 Erection of barriers and signs

- (1) The organiser must ensure that it has sufficient signage in order to be able to comply with this Notice and provide a copy of its plans regarding signage to

the Department not less than 6 weeks prior to the start of any road traffic restriction or such shorter period as the Department may specify.


- (2) The organiser must ensure that signage is erected and maintained immediately before, or as soon as possible after, the beginning of every restricted period, and in any event before the relevant part of the course is used for the event.
- (3) The organiser must ensure that the signage referred to in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) –
 - (a) is erected and maintained in accordance with the plans provided to the Department under sub-paragraph (1); and
 - (b) is clearly visible to approaching traffic.
- (4) The organiser must ensure that the signage referred to in this paragraph is removed at the end of every restricted period.

12 Insurance

The organiser must secure insurances and indemnities against death, injury or damage to persons or damage to property arising out of the conduct of the event or arrangements incidental to them of at least two million pounds (£2,000,000).
